

NYS Education and Training Voucher Program

Supporting Your Future



The Education and Training Voucher (ETV) Program of New York State helps youth who are currently or were formerly in foster care with their post-secondary education or vocational training expenses.

- ▶ ETV provides **up to \$5,000** per year to youth who are younger than 26 years of age.
- ▶ Students can apply for **up to five years of funding**.
- ▶ Funding must start **before** a student's **21st birthday**.

Awards can be used for

- ▶ tuition
- ▶ fees
- ▶ books
- ▶ supplies
- ▶ housing
- ▶ transportation

Plus other costs related to your education and training.
