NYS Education and Training Voucher Program Supporting Your Future



The Education and Training Voucher (ETV) Program of New York State helps youth who are currently or were formerly in foster care with their postsecondary education or vocational training expenses.

- ETV provides up to \$5,000 per year to youth who are younger than 26 years of age.
- Students can apply for up to five years of funding.
- Funding must start before a student's 21st birthday.
